## Pricing Outline: Assessment Levels 1 & 2

**\*\*NOTE: Room/Board/Tuition Costs are subject to change**

### **Assessment**

**Due at start of Two Weeks: \$1100.00:**

- \$ 500 Security Deposit; \$250 Refundable depending upon space when existing the program or graduating to Level 3.
- \$ 600 Two Week Assessment Fee

---

### **Level 1: Dormitory**

**Room/Board/Tuition: \$1696 Monthly:**

- \$ 761 Room and Board (Food & Bills included)
- \$ 935 Tuition

**Dine Out: \$10-\$15 Every Friday**

*Students can write spending check for cash or use debit card.*

**Weekend Outings: \$10-\$15 Every Weekend**

*Students can include in spending check for cash or use debit card.*

### **Level 2: Apartments**

**Rent/Cable/Tuition: \$1396 Monthly:**

- \$ 568 Rent
- \$ 37 Cable
- \$ 791 Tuition

---

**NOTE:**

**In Level 2, in addition to the fixed costs listed above, the student is also responsible for:**

- Assuming their own electric costs
- Shopping for groceries/household need
- Dine Out/Weekend Outings/Special Outings

## **Graduation/Level 3 Option: SLIL Condos**

*\*\* Storey Lane Independent Living (SLIL) is the sister organization of AFIL. SLIL provides a long-term independent living option once students graduate from AFIL. SLIL has two condo buildings, and each building has a live-in supervisor.*

<b>Rent</b>	<b>\$750 (if renting) (purchase of a condo is also available)</b>
<b>Monthly COA Dues</b>	<b>\$150-310 (varies depending on building and sq. footage of condo)</b>
<b>Monthly SLIL Fee</b>	<b>\$270 (pays for onsite supervisor, transportation, recreation)</b>

### **NOTE:**

**In Level 3, in addition to the fixed costs listed above, the resident is also responsible for:**

- **Assuming their own utility costs (water and internet are included in the COA dues fee)**
  - **Cable**
  - **Shopping for groceries/household needs**
  - **Special Outings**
